1. Balancing issues to be addressed

1. Balancing Stakeholder Group and Balancing Pilot Projects

- a) The Balancing Stakeholder Group's (BSG) relationship with the MESC is unclear, while it is clear that the BAL NC is defined as a Market Code.
- b) We recommend formally adopting the BSG as a subgroup of the MESC.
- 2. The stakeholder involvement in Balancing Pilot Projects (BPP) is unclear and not easy to cover with the current BSG set-up
 - a) One option is that the BSG has a subgroup for each BPP.
 - b) Possibly better (more frequent & with a wider involvement) is if European associations can nominate SPOCs for each BPP, and that each BPP is required to liaison with SPOCs with regard to developments in this BPP.
- 3. The BSG and the development of details in the Balancing NC needs to consider and respect links towards, and needs of, the Intra Day Markets
 - a) For instance, Balancing Arrangements after Single Intra Day Coupling GCT must take into account and reflect the time needed for making arrangements to secure the orderly final matching/ settlement/ scheduling/ shipping of relevant ID trades.
