

- **Common proposal for a set of requirements and for the establishment of the single allocation platform and methodology for sharing the cost of establishing, developing and operating the single allocation platform**
- Pursuant to Articles 49.1 and 59 of the FCA GL. Deadline for TSOs to submit their proposals: 17 April 2017
- First discussion with ENTSO-E in the last Coordination Group meeting
- Main concerns for NRAs:
  - Many important aspects of the SAP proposal are actually moved to a future “Cooperation Agreement” which reduces the value of the current proposal
  - If TSOs are not ready to provide the draft Cooperation Agreement at the same time of submission of the SAP proposal, NRAs may not approve the proposal
  - TSOs should explain how the principle of no discrimination is ensured and provide more information on the SAP operator (legal nature, obligations, unbundling from other activities...)
  - From a formal point of view, is the designation (within the proposal) of a specific company to perform the role of SAP Operator acceptable?
  - Regarding governance, are the qualified majority principles efficient for operational decisions? What role for the SAP operator in those decisions?
