Update on all TSOs' proposals

Scheduled exchanges methodologies

- Process
 - All TSOs' proposals approved and submitted to all NRAs by the end of February
- Content
 - Main point: inclusion or not of Nemo trading hub (NTH) in the proposals
 - Using the NTH calculation approach requires NEMOs' permission
 - TSOs increased the level of detail provided in the proposal but in the absence of permission, TSOs decided not to include the NTH in the SEC proposals
 - It should be reminded that NTH cannot be considered a geographic area and thus is out of the scope of the SEC proposals

Update on all TSOs' proposals

CCR request for amendment

- New amendment request to be submitted to all NRAs
- Content
 - Hansa: New bidding zone border between DK1-NL, Cobra link implementation
 - Core: Additional TSO to be added in the existing BE-DE/LU bidding zone border
 - Channel: Two TSOs to be added in the existing FR-GB bidding zone border

FCA CID

- Proposal due by mid-June 2018
- Principles of the CACM CID to be used as a basis

Proposals linked with regulatory approval


- IDCZGT: ACER decision expected in April 2018
